Sand Hollow Resort is inviting all of its neighbors in Southern Utah to a free block party. This 10-day event kicks off on Friday, Feb. 15, with

Miss Utah "G.I. Jill" Stevens on hand to meet area residents and hand out free Fat Boy ice cream on behalf of the Children's Miracle Network.

"We want everyone to have the chance to get to know us and we want every-

one to come out and have fun," event coordinator Cindy Willey said. Though the block party is timed with the Parade of Homes, Sand Hollow does not require a Parade ticket. "There's no fee to get in, and there are a lot of great things to do and see at no charge."

Chief among them will be the free helicopter rides. From 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. on both weekends, A Flight Above will take guests up for a bird's eye view of the dramatic scenery around Sand Hollow. The line is sure to be long for these rides, but for a \$2 minimum donation to the Children's Miracle Network, riders will

receive a special Sand Hollow golf ball. Sink a putt with one of those golf balls and earn Sand Hollow's own version of a Fast Pass for the helicopter ride. "Get as many as you like. The golf balls can also be used for discounts on food and other items at the booths," Willey said.

Nearly 30 booths will feature area businesses ranging from Stephen Wade Power Sports and Desert Cyclery to Paradise Pools and Jones Paint and Glass; food providers include The Steak & Seafood Co. and Fat Boy Ice Cream.

tours of the golf course will be offered during the party so area golfers can get a sneak peek at what will be available in October when Sand Hollow Resort Golf Course officially opens for play.

Established and managed by the same company responsible for Thanksgiving Point, Sand Hollow's main course is an 18-hole championship golf that according to sales director Darrel Stephens "rivals the best courses in the state." This is a public course and is designed to challenge good players. "There are thoughtful risk/reward challenges to every shot," Stephens said. "Combine that with the rock cliffs and spectacular views throughout and you're in for a great round." In addition to the 18-hole main course, Sand Hollow will also offer a traditional 9-hole, St. Andrews-style links course and an 18-hole, greens-only putting course.
